



## New to Scotiabank?

To open your first account with Scotiabank, here's what you will need:

- 1** **Your Identification: Minimum of one valid form:**
  - Passport OR National ID Card OR Driver's License with proof of nationality.
- 2** **Your Proof of Address:**
  - Utility Bill (not older than 6 months and excluding mobile) OR Tax Assessment OR Bank Statement OR Contract for Rental from Landlord.
- 3** **Your Proof of Income / Occupation:**
  - Job Letter OR Pay Slip – most recent.
  - Self-Employed – Proof of income generation in the business name e.g. Bank Statements, Receipt Books, Contracts.
- ➔** **If You're A Foreign Client, in addition to the above:**
  - A Reference Letter from your Foreign Bank OR Bank Statement.
  - Your Tax Identification Information.
- ➔** **If you are adding joint parties or signatories**
  - Be sure to walk with their documentation as above.
- 1** **Next visit the branch most convenient to you**
